Show respect for the adults, other youth, and children attending The Amazing Race Summer Adventure. This includes, but is not limited to:

- being on time
- following directions the first time they are given
- participating to the best of your ability in every part of The Amazing Race Summer Adventure, including singing, games, and clean-up
- having a positive attitude
- being respectful in speech
- being respectful in actions
- keeping all electronic equipment turned off (cell phones, iPods, etc.)

Respect the facility and church property. This includes, but is not limited to :

- eating and drinking at designated snack times in designated snack areas only
- keeping out of areas of the church not designated for The Amazing Race Summer Adventure

If the Code of Conduct is broken, possible actions will include:

- Discussion with an adult leader
- Discussion with The Amazing Race Summer Adventure Director
- Parent phone call
- Parent phone call with request that youth is picked up immediately and is not invited back.
